The Hennepin Canal Feeder (on the National Register of Historical Places) extends from Rock Falls to Sheffield. The Hennepin Canal Feeder opens the door to the parkway, with miles of bike and hiking paths, horseback riding, canoeing, fishing, and historical sites all located along the way. At the mouth of the feeder is the Hydro Electric Plant completed in 1988 and is the first such plant constructed in Illinois since 1927.
